Medway is steeped in history, with a strong heritage. It offers some fantastic photo opportunities including Rochester Cathedral and the grounds of Rochester Castle. There are a number of local suppliers that can help you with your special day, from florists and caterers to bridal shops and car hire.

Medway also has its own register office as well as a range of licensed venues.

Transport links in Medway are excellent. It's surrounded by the M2, M25 and M20 and has regular direct trains into London.














Your perfect venue is closer than you think

Upnor Castle

Set in the picturesque riverside village of Upnor, Upnor Castle is a rare example of an Elizabethan artillery fort. Backed with rolling hills, architectural brilliance, natural beauty and wonderful photo opportunities, your special day will be captured against this unique backdrop of history; one of England's truly timeless places.

Wander back through time as you make your way down the enchanting cobbled high street to the grand entrance gates, where you will pass through the beautiful studded oak doors of the gatehouse, finding the grassed inner courtyard.

Climb the wooden stairs to the upper floor, which was once a store for munitions and now the wedding room's novel powderbarrel seating, echoing the castle's historic past.

Please note: Upnor Castle is closed between 1 November to 31 March.



Eastgate House

Built in 1590, Eastgate House is a Grade I listed Elizabethan town house and is one of the most impressive and distinctive buildings in Rochester's historic high street.

This magnificent building has been a family home, a Victorian School and a museum - it has many tales to tell.

This venue was an inspiration to the great author Charles Dickens, featuring in *The Pickwick Papers* and *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*. The splendid oak-panelled ceremony room features a gorgeous fireplace and offers a true sense of occasion.

The Guildhall

Located in the heart of Rochester, The Guildhall is bursting with character and charm, creating a truly captivating setting for your ceremony.

Built in 1687, it has been a town hall, entertainment venue, court and a council chamber. Now a museum, it displays more than 250,000 years of Medway's history.

The chamber is a fine example of 17th century interior decoration, with its magnificent painted plaster ceilings and large decorative oil paintings.

The stunning red-carpeted, sweeping staircase leads you to the chamber entrance where you will be spellbound by the grandeur of this historic venue. The glittering chandeliers offer the perfect soft ambience for your ceremony.

Guests: 70 seated 20 standing (ceremony only)



The Corn Exchange

The sweeping staircase, high ceilings, incredible chandeliers and stunning architecture make The Corn Exchange the perfect wedding venue.

Set in the heart of historic Rochester, this exclusive venue is fully licensed, meaning you can hold your reception, wedding and civil partnership ceremonies in one place. Or if you choose to get married elsewhere we can just host your reception.

Previously known as the Clock House, this building dates back to 1698. To commemorate a visit from Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip in 1961, the two main rooms were renamed – The Queens Hall (which caters for weddings up to 300 guests) and The Princes Hall (up to 80 guests).

The Rochester Corn Exchange offers you complete flexibility. You are able to bring your own caterers, source your own music and decorate as you wish. There are a number of packages on offer which all include full use of tables and chairs, as well as a fully stocked and staffed bar (package dependant).















Rochester
